In school, we are learning all about Toys old and new. To support this at home we would like you to complete some challenges...

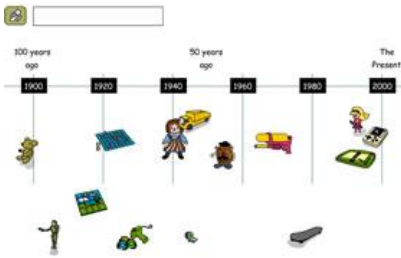


Research!

Can you find out how old that toy is? Can you compare it to one of your toys? What is the same? What is different?



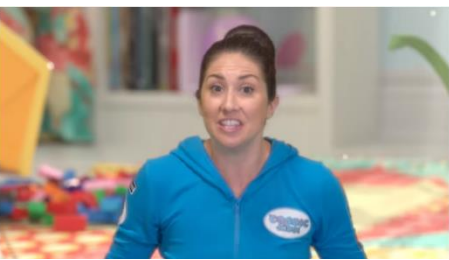
History.
