

Connected Curriculum Year 2 Summer 2: Life and Culture of a Non-European Country.

At school Year 2 are learning about life in Mexico and how life there is different to life in Mainland UK. To support this work at home, we would like you to investigate what life is like in another South American country: the country of Peru!

- Where is Peru? What continent is it in? Have a look at an Atlas and have a go at drawing a map of the country. Mark in famous landmarks or physical features.
- What is the local habitat and weather like? What sort of creatures live there?
- Find out what Peru is famous for. Why do tourists visit? Are there any famous Peruvians?
- How is Peruvian culture different to English Culture? Find out about their traditional food, music, dance and costume.
- Compare a day in a Peruvian child's life to your day.
- What sort of jobs do people have? How are they similar or different to jobs in the UK?
- How are houses and other buildings adapted to suit the Peruvian climate and weather?
