Reading

Try and read for 15 minutes each day.

When you are reading stories, try to identify and talk about how the characters are feeling. Does the writer leave any clues?

When reading stories aloud to an adult, try to use the punctuation and powerful verbs (e.g. whispered, screeched) to add expression. Can you use an angry voice, an excited voice or a scared voice.
