Can you tell a family member what happens in the story in order? Could you write the story using time conjunctions?

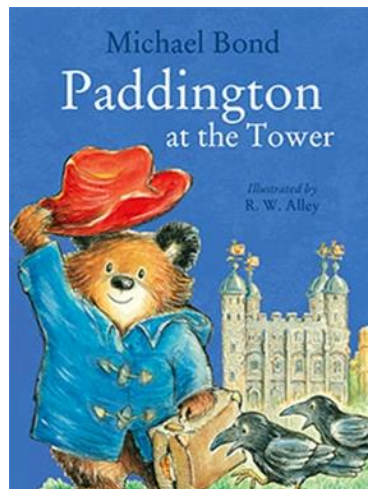

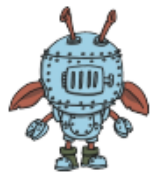
