English

Maths



We will be learning about addition and subtraction methods including mental, number line and column.

We will begin multiplication and division work too. You could practise the 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables.

Learning fact families will also help.
e.g. $5 \times 4 = 20$, $4 \times 5 = 20$, $20 \div 5 = 4$,
 $20 \div 4 = 5$
