



## Picknalls First School Year 2 Spring 2: In the Forest



In **Geography** we will be drawing maps of the woodland walk, and looking at

maps and co-ordinates.



In **Science** we will be looking at plants and observing how they grow. We will plant some seeds and bulbs.



In **ICT** we will investigate route-based programs and sequences in JiT5 Turtle.

**D&T:** We will make puppets of LRRH and the Wolf; **ART:** We will create black and white charcoal drawings of wolves; clay work creating forest creatures; create printed forest scenes.

Within **P.E** we will be developing our games skills including throwing and catching, net and wall games, building towards team games.

**RHE:** Road safety and Stranger Danger. **RE:** To understand the importance of belonging to a religion and recognise the difference this can make to our lives; learning the Easter story. **Music and songs** linked to topic: Who's Afraid Of the Big Bad Wolf (Little Red Riding Hood), Peter and the Wolf. BBC School's Radio music and drama Little Red Riding Hood.

### English



During this half term we will be reading different versions of Little Red Riding Hood. We will be writing letters, making persuasive leaflets and posters, and recounting traditional stories in our own words. We will focus on the correct use of punctuation, and introduce adjectives to make our writing more interesting. We will write newspaper reports, and non-fiction reports about wolves. Phonics will be taught daily. Children will read individually and as part of a small group.



### Maths

Maths will focus on measurement: length, height, mass, capacity and temperature. We will cover units of measurement and compare and order different lengths and heights. We will use the four operations with length, volume, and capacity. We will continue to work on the 2, 3, 5 & 10 X tables.
