Nursery - Summer 1 - April/May 2023

English – This half term we will be continuing to focus on the foundations of literacy. Children need to be secure in this before they move onto letter sound acquisition during Reception. The following link may be useful: - https://www.letters-and-sounds.com/phase-1.html We will also continue to look at some phase 2 letter sounds. We will recap s, a and t as well as introducing p, i and n. We start with these sounds as it is possible to start blending, hearing and reading words e.g. sat, pin and tap. Why not try some of these activities at home.

Action Songs - Singing songs and action rhymes is a vital part of Phase One phonics and should be an everyday event. Children need to develop a wide repertoire of songs and rhymes. Be sure to include multi-sensory experiences such as action songs in which children have to add claps, knee pats and foot stamps or move in a particular way. I spy something beginning with t... Make sure you use the sound not the name of the letter for example t not T. Can you spy something for each letter of the alphabet?


