English

We will continue to work on spelling patterns and rules. With a focus on the year 3 and 4 statutory spelling list.

This half term will be a time for the children to present their year's learning. This will be done through story writing and persuasive texts. They will continue to develop their editing and proof reading skills.

Maths



We will be continuing our measures topic focusing on time. Children should be encouraged to develop their understanding of both analogue and digital time. Next, we will learn about angles measuring and comparing them. We will then move on to statistics learning about pictograms, bar charts and tables. We will finish the year white Rose revisiting calculations.

We will continue our recorder playing and work on our own compositions.
