RE

Our RE topic is Worship. We will look at the main features of worship and discuss the importance of worship for believers. We will focus on Christian and Islam faiths.



Art /D&T

Our Art week this half term will be based around our topic of Uttoxeter. We will use a variety of media to create artwork about buildings and places in Uttoxeter.

In DT we will be looking at seasonal food. We are planning to prepare a picnic for our end of year celebration using skills taught last year.





Physical Education

In PE we will be developing our athletic skills- running, jumping and throwing. The children will continue to participate in striking and fielding games, such as rounders and diamond cricket. We will also develop our tennis skills, building up rallies and improving timing, forehand and backhand strokes.

Relationship and Health Education

Our focus will be on eating healthily. We will look at nutritional information on packaged food, looking at sugar, salt and saturated fat. We will explore what is meant by a balanced diet and plan a balanced meal. As well as diet we will look at how exercise can help us keep healthy.

All Change! Summer 2 Year 4

English

In English we will be focusing on narrative texts using a range of Marvel texts. A variety of media will be used to stimulate writing including comic books, ebooks and video.

Our writing target continues to be the development of more complex punctuation, in particular direct speech, using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause, as well as using fronted adverbials.

Our reading target focuses on drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence. We will also be predicting what might happen from details stated and implied.





Computing

In **ICT** we will go revisit Scratch to introduce movement blocks to animate sprites, changing backgrounds and using conditional statements If. Then.. Reinforcing sequence, repetition, and selection in programming.



History and Geography

We will explore how Uttoxeter has changed over the years. We will look at what Uttoxeter is like today and then our visit to Redfern cottage where we will be able to look at old photos, maps and other artefacts. Children will be given opportunities to ask questions of others' memories of Uttoxeter. We will carry out our own fieldwork in the town, including a visit to the park.





Music

We will continue to learn to play the ukulele and learn new songs for our end of year concert at Stafford Showground.

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MFL

In French we will be doing our transition project for our new middle schools. This year we will be reading the story of 'Le petit chaperon rouge' (Little Red Riding Hood).



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Maths

In Maths we will continue to look at how to write money using decimals, compare, estimate and calculate as well as solving problems.

We will be telling the time on analogue and digital clocks, converting analogue times to digital using both the 12 hour and 24 hour clock.

Children will be interpreting data using bar charts, pictograms and tables and introduced to line graphs.

We will be revisiting shape and angles, identifying similarities and differences between quadrilaterals. Children will recognise different types of triangle. They will also explore symmetry.

Children will be introduced to coordinates for the first time.

Science

In Science we will start off by looking at food chains. Children will research food chains and learn how to construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey. We will compare food chains in different habitats. In addition we will revisit the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature. We will carry out investigations to support and test our ideas and use our ICT skills to research the water cycle.
