



Picknalls First School Year 2 Spring 2 2023-24: Looking after Our World.



In **Geography** we will study the environment including the effects of littering, pollution and how to combat it.  We will investigate recycling and endangered wildlife.

In **Science** we will be studying a range of seeds and bulbs and observing how they grow. We will learn about seed dispersal and conditions for germination. We will plant seeds and bulbs.

In **ICT** we will develop an understanding of interpreting data from a chart - using  Jit Chart and Pictogram tools.

Within **P.E** we will be developing our Rounders skills including throwing and fielding.

In **Dance** lessons we will create dances using simple movement patterns.

RHE: Looking After Our World, We will study recycling and the relationship between humans and planet Earth.

RE: To understand the importance of belonging to a religion and recognise the difference this can make to our lives; learning the Easter story.

In **Music** we will learn to play the glockenspiel.



English

This half term we begin with report writing based around our exciting *Gorilla week*. We will research non-fiction sources for this.

This will be followed by further developing our letter writing skills, using the fiction text "Dear Greenpeace".

We will then revisit report writing on the topic of pollution using a range of non-fiction sources. We will finish the half term studying Spring poetry and develop our own poetry writing skills. Wandle spelling lessons will continue daily.



Maths

will focus on measurement: length, height, mass, capacity and temperature. We will cover units of measurement and compare and order different lengths and heights. We will use the four operations with length, volume, and capacity. We will continue to work on the 2, 3, 5 & 10 X tables.
