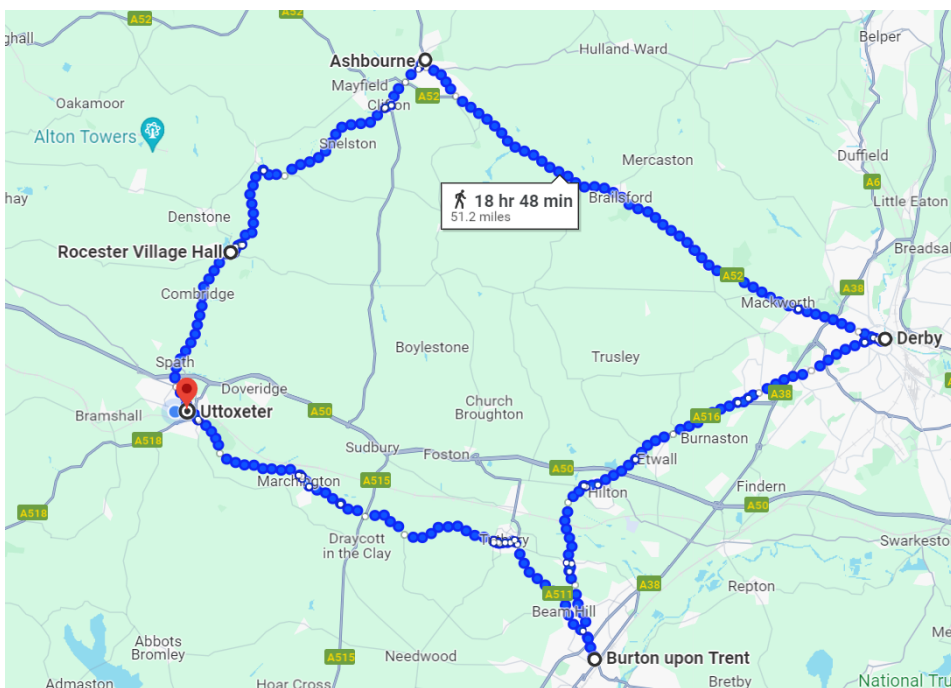


Mr Cope - Marathon Man!

Mr Cope has never been one to do things by halves! This year he wasn't satisfied with running just one marathon, he has opted to put himself through two of them! Not only that but he will only have a week to recuperate between them! He is running the [Manchester Marathon](#) on Sunday 14th April followed by the [London Marathon](#) on Sunday 21st April, 52.4 miles in total! We've calculated that as being almost the equivalent of running from Uttoxeter to Burton-on-Trent to Derby to Ashbourne to Rocester and back to Uttoxeter!

Why is he putting himself through this? Yes, because he's mad but also to raise £2,000 for the [Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation \(JDRF\)](#) which funds several different research projects trying to find a cure to Type 1 Diabetes. We have had several pupils at Picknalls over the years who Mr Cope has taught and supported, so it is a cause which is close to our hearts. We will be supporting his fund-raising efforts by having a non-uniform day on Friday 12th April, please bring a small donation and on Friday 19th April Mr Cope will host a Cake Sale after school, for which we would welcome all baked donations. Cost of Living

The cost-of-living crisis is not easing, and we are aware that some families are struggling. We were pleased to hear that the [Household Support fund](#) has been extended until September 2024. Each eligible household benefits from a £65.00 supermarket voucher and a further £20.00 supermarket voucher per additional dependant every term.

In addition to this they have introduced the [Utility Debt Support](#) scheme which anyone with a utility debt can ask to be referred by us to apply for a grant of £450 to be paid directly to their energy supplier.

There are no set criteria for eligibility as these schemes are designed to help families who are on a low income but may not be entitled to benefits. We can refer families that we know need extra support, but we can't do this without you coming forward. If you would like to be referred, please speak to us. This will be strictly confidential as we are very keen to remove any perceived stigma attached to applying. Applications are open from 2nd April 2024 - 30th September 2024,

Thank you for completing our annual Parent Questionnaire when you attended Parents' Evening last October. During their away day the Governors took the time to digest the results and were gratified to learn that 93% of families agreed/strongly agreed that Picknalls responds well to any concerns they have raised. This supports the pride we take in sustaining highly positive relationships with all our families.

Health & Safety

The children and staff responded brilliantly to our recent Fire Evacuation practice. The purpose of practising evacuation and lock down procedure is to ensure that everyone on site knows what to do in the event of a real emergency.

We tackle these aspects sensitively and in an age appropriate manner with the children in order to explain why this is an important thing to rehearse without instilling a sense of fear.



Late Pick Up



Unfortunately we have recently seen a rise in the number of children being collected late from school. For one off exceptional circumstances we will, of course, supervise children if you are unable to organise collection on time but we cannot support ongoing persistent late pick ups.

Our staff may have prior commitments such as a staff meeting or an after school club and some children can become anxious if they haven't been collected at the same time as their friends.

It is with regret that we feel from now on if your child is regularly not collected at their expected leaving time we will have no choice other than to place them in the care of our wraparound before and after school club, [Happy Hours](#) who will charge you for their service.

Please remember to keep your contact details up-to-date as we will attempt to contact you if you have failed to inform us.

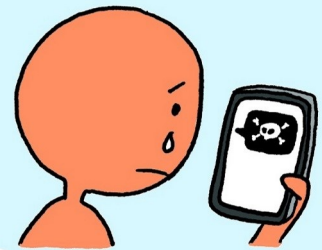

Using social media, even in private groups, is not constructive and the school can't improve or address issues unless they are raised in an appropriate way.

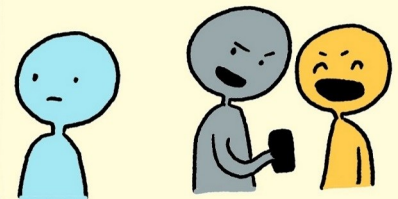

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We're using Arbor's free Parent Portal and Parent App



We've chosen [Arbor](#) to help us manage our school.

Arbor is a simple, smart and cloud-based MIS (Management Information System), which helps us work faster, smarter and more collaboratively as a school. The Parent App and Parent Portal mean we can keep you informed about your child's life at school in a much more accessible way. You will be able to log into Arbor to see and update your child's information, get live updates and make payments or bookings on the go!

Eventually the Arbor Portal and App will replace ParentPay, SIMs Parent, Teachers2Parents and Parents Evening Booking.

We are swapping from ParentPay to Arbor on 30th April, therefore **it is essential that you do not make any payments or meal bookings through ParentPay after 26th April. Any payments made after this date may not be transferred over and may be lost.**

The Parent Portal works on Google Chrome (computer or laptop) and you can download the Parent App from the App Store or Google Play Store on your phone (Android 5.0; iOS 10.0 and upwards).

How to get started

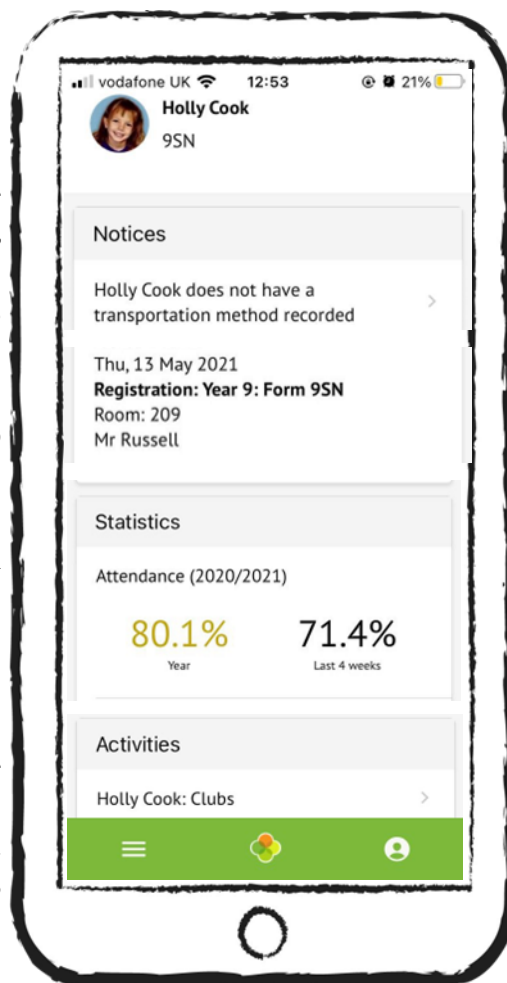
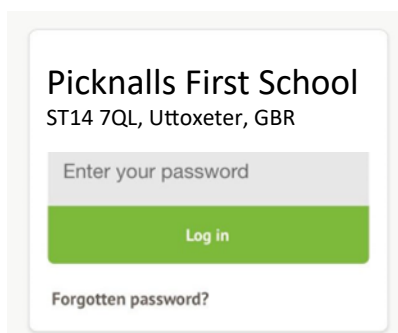
- **Wait for your welcome email** from us telling you Arbor is ready - **you will not be able to log in before**
- Click the link in your welcome email to set up your password
- Go to the App or Google Play Store on your phone and search 'Arbor'
- Click 'Install' on Android or 'Get' on iPhone then open the App
- Enter your email, select the school, then enter your password
- Accept the Terms & Conditions and enter your child's birthday

Need help using Arbor?

- Contact the school office if you have questions about Arbor, the App or Parent Portal. Tell us the type and model of your phone, e.g. an iPhone SE, and include screenshots or screen recordings
- To safeguard student data in line with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), Arbor only works directly with schools.

Some tips to try:

- Ensure your username is the email address you use for Arbor. Ask us to check the email address linked to your account.
- Reset your password from the login page, or ask us to do this.
- If the login email was sent to you more than 96 hours ago, the password link will have expired. Ask us to send it again.
- Ask the school office to check that your email address has not been used twice - e.g. on another guardian or child's profile.
- Enter the birthday of one of your children to log in.
- Only relatives who are Primary Guardians of a child can access the Arbor App. Ask us to check you can access Arbor.
- [Arbor's Help Centre](#) has lots of online guides which explain features in more detail (Please note: we may not use every feature available such as behaviour points as this is not applicable to our school)

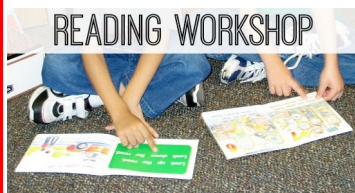


Red Nose Day

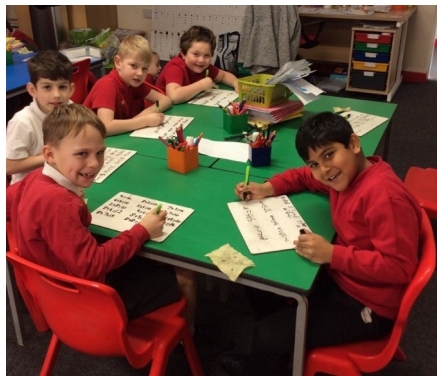


Minibus

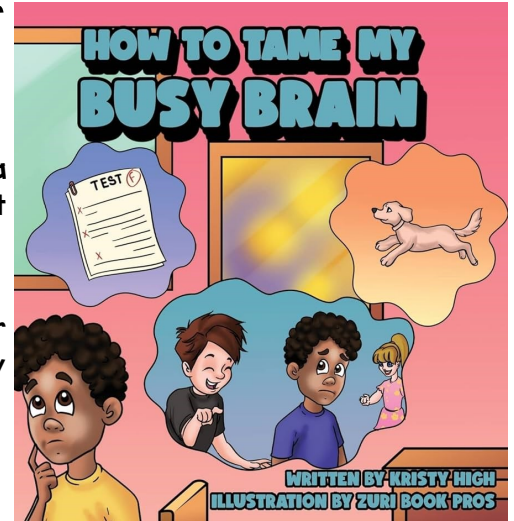
Busy Brain Workshop

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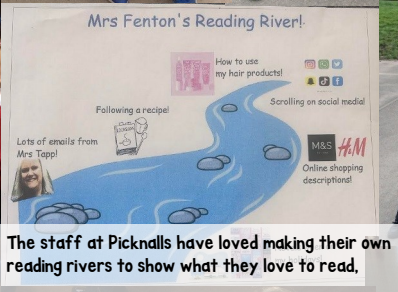
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World Book Week



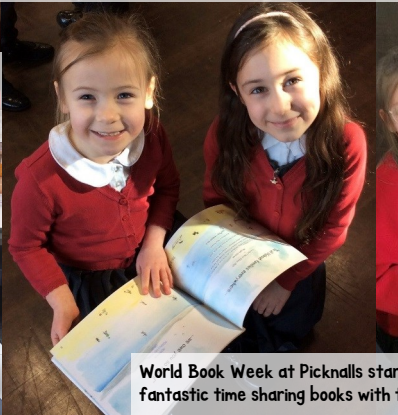
Class 2 celebrated World Book Day with some amazing costumes.

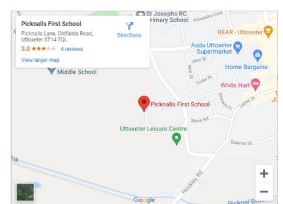
