



Picknalls First School Year 2 Summer 1: Into the Forest.



In **Geography** we will be drawing maps of the woodland walk as well as studying maps and co-ordinates. [What are maps? - BBC Bitesize](#) In **Science** we will continue to study plants and observe how they grow over time. We will learn the scientific words to explain the stages of a plant's development.



In **ICT** we will investigate route-based programs and sequences in Jit5 Turtle.

D&T: We will design, make and evaluate puppets of LRRH and the Wolf;

ART: We will create black and white charcoal drawings of wolves; experience clay work creating forest creatures and create printed forest scenes.

Within **P.E.** we will be developing our Athletic skills and our Fitness improving our speed, agility, balance and co-ordination.

RHE: Road safety and Stranger Danger.

RE: Storytelling through sacred writings.

Music and songs linked to topic: Who's Afraid of the Big Bad Wolf (Little Red Riding Hood), Peter and the Wolf.

BBC School's Radio music and drama Little Red Riding Hood.

English



During this half term we will be reading different versions of Little Red Riding Hood. We will be creating character and setting descriptions. We will rewrite a traditional tale. We will focus on the correct use of punctuation and adjectives to make our writing more interesting. We will write non-fiction reports about wolves. Phonics and spelling will be taught daily. Children will read individually or as part of a group.



Maths

We will focus on measurement: mass, capacity and temperature. We will compare and order within the different units of measure. We will continue to work on the 2, 3, 5 & 10 X tables. We will study fractions from recognising a whole and parts, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, moving on to unit and non-unit fractions. Equivalent fractions will also be studied.
