English

We will continue to work on spelling patterns and rules. With a focus on the year 3 and 4 statutory spelling list.



This half term we will write and perform a speech to persuade people to be a roman soldier. We will also write a recount of the life of a roman soldier. Finishing off the year with some summer poetry.



Maths



We will be continuing our measures topic focusing on time. Children should be encouraged to develop their understanding of both analogue and digital time. Next, we will learn about angles measuring and comparing them. We will then move on to statistics learning about pictograms, bar charts and tables. We will finish the year revisiting calculations.



Music

We will continue our recorder playing and work on our own compositions.



History



We will explore life in Roman times in Britain. Their homes, invasions and life as a soldier.

PE

We will learn the skills needed for cricket and rounders. We will develop our orienteering skills



Art and DT

Linking to the Romans we will create mosaic tiles, patterns, design and make our own shields.



RE

We will learn about religious leaders and how they have impacted our world.
