<u>History</u>

This half term, we will begin to understand chronology by using the terms past, present, modern and old. We will identify similarities and differences between the past and present. We will identify that over time, some things change and

some things stay the same.

<u>P.E.</u>

This half term in year 1, we will be building on our throwing and catching skills from Autumn 1 and putting what we have learnt into netball games and skills. We will also be developing a routine as a whole class in dance.

<u>RHE:</u>

This half term, we will be focusing on keeping and staying safe. We will be looking in detail at healthy eating and brushing our teeth correctly. We will engage in class discussions about good choices to keep us safe alongside the support from Deedee.

<u>Science</u>

We will be naming our body parts as well as identifying and exploring the senses.

In DT we will explore the concepts of freestanding structures and the importance of inclusive design in public spaces. By designing and creating models of playground equipment, they will develop practical skills in cutting, joining, folding, and strengthening materials, using construction kits and junk modelling.

<u>Music</u>.

This half term we will be focusing on pitch, timbre and structure. We will use 'Transport' to look at these areas.

English

This half term in Phonics, we will begin to learn our Phase 5 sounds when reading. We will work hard to start applying these into our writing. We will still focus on ensuring we can structure a sentence and use a capital letter, finger space and full stop. We will also begin to introduce adjectives into our work to add detail to our sentences. We will use the tricky work 'I' in our writing and start to use conjunctions to extend our sentences. We will read a book a week and some of these include; Winter sleep, The lost property Office, meet the weather and Edgar.

Maths

This half term, we will mostly be looking at addition and subtraction within 10. We will use part-whole models to help us add and subtract and understand our number fact families. We will learn how to write addition and subtraction number sentences and solve problems. We will learn our number bonds within and to 10. Towards the end of this half term, we will begin to look at 2D and 3D shapes. We will name and sort the shapes and explore patterns with shapes.
