

Year 2 Spring 2 Curriculum Information



Science

Living things and their Habitats

We will explore where animals live and what adaptations allow them to live there. The children will revisit the terms omnivore, herbivore and carnivore then explore simple food chains.



History

Flight—To know how air travel has impacted upon society. We will look at significant individuals and predict how air travel will look in the future.



English



In English this half term we will be reading a new story called Daisy and the Trouble with London.

We will continue our spelling units following the Little Wandle scheme. They will continue to practice the year 2 spelling words that can be found on the website.

We will also be writing non chronological reports and exploring character and setting descriptions.

Design and Technology

Wheels and Axels— The children will research, design and create a prototype for a litter picking trolley. They will then evaluate their creations.



Music

Orchestra—The children will learn the families of musical instruments and listen to them in a variety of different musical pieces. They will explore how music and sound effects convey emotion.



Computing

Impact of technology on the world— We will explain the rules of acceptable use of technology. We will explore how technology has changed over time.



Maths



In Maths this half term the children will be understanding measurements of length and height in cm and m, they will compare and order these and use all four operations to calculate word problems.

They will also be learning about mass using the units of g and kg and also capacity using l and ml. Again, ordering and comparing and calculating.

PE

Dance—The pupils will learn a sequence of movements and actions to perform a dance

Dodgeball—Children will learn to send and receive a ball at different speeds focusing on accuracy and direction.



RE and RHE

Belonging to a Group—Pupils will explore the importance for some people of belonging to a religion or a community group.

Keeping and Staying Safe—The pupils will learn about stranger danger
