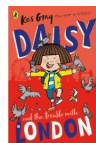


Geography

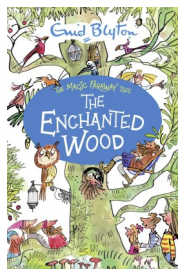
We will be learning about the diverse location of Tanzania, identifying physical features such as mountains, bodies of water and human features.



English



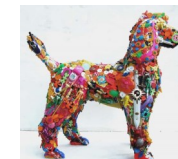
In English this half term we will be finishing our book Daisy and the Trouble with London. Then we will move on to The Enchanted Wood by Enid Blyton.

Art

Sculpture—Using recycled items to design and create an animal, we will focus on joining techniques and the work of a famous sculptor.

Animals—Using a drawing app create repeated patterns and camouflage effects. Use labels and texts and voice notes to enhance their work.



Maths



In Maths this half term the children will be learning about fractions with equal and unequal parts. Specifically learning about halves, quarters and thirds, unit and non unit fractions.

We will then move onto time: o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, finally learning 5 minute intervals.
